## Arizona immigrant law is topic of forum

EL PASO -- The issue of illegal immigration and the Arizona state law that has caused so much controversy will be the subject of a forum presented by the El Paso Press Club at 10 a.m. Saturday at the El Paso Times, 300 N. Campbell. The Arizona law allows a law enforcement officer to ask the immigration status of a person if the officer has a "reasonable suspicion" the person is in the country illegally.

The panelists will include city Rep. Susie Byrd, who helped draft a resolution for the City Council condemning the Arizona immigration law, and county judge candidate Jaime O. Perez, who is advocating for tougher sanctions against undocumented immigrants. Kathleen Campbell Walker, an El Paso lawyer who specializes in immigration, will round out the panel.
